No religion in the world has been so stigmatized like voodoo. The word finds its origin in the Fon language in Benin and means God. The vodun are the old gods of Benin. The well known photographer and anthropologist Henning Christoph spent many years researching and documenting rituals and ceremonies that have never been seen before by outsiders. Never before has a book shown such a wealth of photos illustrating this fascinating misunderstood religion.
